




Invitation

The main objective of the MELODY project was to define, develop and deploy a harmonised CBRN training curriculum for first responders and medical staff, including ambulance drivers, paramedics and emergency room (ER) personnel. The target group includes members of agencies that are responsible for dealing with emergencies, being unintentional or intentional releases of CBRN, which require immediate action. The MELODY CBRN training curriculum helps first responders obtain a clear picture of the possible consequences and effects and how to act together in a safe and effective and efficient way.
